

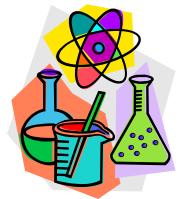
JOHN GREEN ELEMENTARY SCHOOL PFC SCIENCE FUN FAIR

Questions about the SCIENCE FUN FAIR?

WHAT IS THE SCIENCE FUN FAIR?

The Science Fun Fair is a non-competitive science fair open to all students – kindergarten through fifth grade at John Green Elementary. The event involves the voluntary preparation and then presentation of a science project to their class. Projects are due in class Monday, March 24th. This is prior to the fair so teachers have time to review the projects and have the children present them to the class. The Fun Fair will be held from 6pm - 8pm on Thursday, March 27th. Last names beginning with A-M come from 6-7pm & names beginning with N-Z come from 7-8pm.

IS MY STUDENT REQUIRED TO DO A SCIENCE PROJECT FOR THE SCIENCE FUN FAIR?

Grades 3rd, 4th, and 5th, require a science project as part of their curriculum. Information will be provided by the teacher. However, for Kindergarten, 1st, and 2nd grade, it is voluntary.

WHAT DO I NEED TO KNOW AS A PARENT?

Science projects should be done at home with family support. John Green's Science Fun Fair is going Green! For a complete science project instructional booklet, please visit Green's PFC website at <http://www.johngreenpfc.org>. If you would like a hard copy of the booklet sent home with your student, please let your teacher know or email jgsciencefair2014@gmail.com. We will also have some copies available on the PFC table outside of the school's office. We would like all students to follow the scientific method that is outlined in the booklet. Details for 3rd, 4th, and 5th grade projects will be forth coming from the teachers. Students in Kindergarten, 1st, and 2nd grades, may work alone or in team groups of 2-3. Siblings may work together, but care should be given that students share the work and that all are as involved as much as age allows.

Parent volunteers will be needed to help interview students on Wednesday, March 26th, setup the boards the afternoon of Thursday March 29th and take down the boards at 8pm the evening of the fair, March 28th. Projects are due in class on Monday, March 24th.

WHEN CAN FAMILIES VIEW THE SCIENCE PROJECTS?

Families, friends, and students from John Green Elementary will be invited to come to see all the projects in Green's Multi-Purpose room on Thursday, March 27th, last names beginning with A-M from 6-7pm & last names beginning with N-Z from 7-8pm.
