1. Call meeting to order at 5:40 pm – Gloria Cheng
2. Welcome and Introductions
3. Approve March Minutes
Bridgette made motion, Susan second, all in favor, none opposed, none abstained.
4. Updates and Proposals
 - a. DPIE
Elementary STEM will be at Green this Summer. Mrs. Ventura will be STEM Principal for at least two weeks during the program. We have three full time people, one to write grants. Started STEM program with high school. Now with 1000 students. 27 teachers from all over the district. Teachers teach their passion. Variety of classes. June 12 - July 21. The goal is exposure and having fun while learning. No grading. Students learn while they have fun.
 - b. Principal
 - i. Audio/Visual installation - total cost \$4500. This will be done over the summer if approved. Projector and add protector. Wireless mic system that will be easier to use. Carmen P approves, Gloria second, all approved, none opposed, none abstained
 - ii. St Patrick's Day Parade - good turnout and lots of fun for the kids.
 - iii. School Plan for Student Achievement Survey - Superintendent gave presentation on new dashboard on how student performance is measured. Make sure no students aren't hidden. Discussed how we work on students that exceeded growth and how we account for all student at all levels. 69 responses so far for the survey.

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- iv. There will be a recorder concert for third graders for the first time on May 2nd. Mr. Silva will bring the 4th and 5th grade band.
 - v. We are celebrating 150 years of education in the district. Will work on a team of 3rd grade students to create a skit.
 - vi. Hosted almost 50 students that have been diverted. Discussed concerns of the increase in traffic and the safety of pedestrian. Suggestions included possibly having police presence once a month or speed bumps along the school. Parents driving too fast or on their phone. Dropping off in unsafe zones, not following driving laws.
- c. School Site Council
Dashboard - Had a hard time picking a sub group. Overall in Math and Language arts our students are high performers.
- d. School Board - Dan Cherrier
 - i. Don't have room for everyone right now. The new Jordan Ranch school k-8 will be mostly middle school at first. Targeted to open Aug 2018. Initially there will be no MPR or admin building. Working with budget to get that done. Proposal for new name to go to board on Tuesday, April 25. Regarding High School, we are narrowing sites and we will make announcement early May. Hold 2000 students initially.
- e. President - Gloria
 - i. PFC Board Candidates - treasurer of accounting still open.
 - ii. Updated Bylaws - Updated treasurer rules. Minimum amount of board members pg 4. Susan made motion, Bridgette second, 7 approve, 1 opposed, none abstained.
 - iii. School Support for DI state final - Voting occurred offline. We had 9 votes total. 5 opposed, 4 in favor, none abstained. This proposal was not approved
- f. Vice President/Secretary - Carmen P/Sara
Spring Eggciting Egg Hunt - A proposal was entered after the March PFC Meeting. Voting occurred offline due to the proposed event occurring before the scheduled April PFC Meeting. There were 7 votes total. All in favor, none opposed, none abstained. The event was great. Families enjoyed the beautiful Spring weather and students hunted eggs. There were areas set up for different age/grade level. There were 3800 eggs filled with treats. Students were limited to 10 eggs each.
- g. Vice President - Carmen P
 - i. Yearbook Hard Drive - The hard drive used to store pictures for 5 years has stopped working. Need a bigger drive to transfer pictures and add

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new pictures. \$350 plus tax. 4 TB Hard drive. Lori moves to approve hard drive, Sara second, All in favor, none opposed, none abstained.

- ii. School Supplies - Proposal for school office to purchase school supplies so it's ready for when school starts. Collect additional \$30 at fall check in for basic supplies. We will hold a School Supplies Drive this Spring if approved. There were 15 votes total. Bridgette moves to approve, Donna second, 9 approve, 5 opposed, 1 abstain. This proposal was approved. Will confirm with teachers on items that they need to order in bulk.

h. Director of Programs - Carmen M

Math Kangaroo - 150 students participated. Up from last year. Snacks were provided by pfc. Parents required to stay this year.

i. Tammy Ficarra-

Tile art is same night as family art night. Students can draw their design for the tile. Cafe art will give all the supplies. Couple of dads will help put tile on the planter. Inside will be family art night, outside will be tile art. \$1000 budget will not cover the entire area. Need additional \$500. Carmen P made the motion to approve addition \$500 to increase budget to tile the whole planter. Dr. Ventura second, all approved, none opposed, none abstained.

Lots of events coming up in May. Everything happening at once. Kristen needs to order Minder Binder for next year and needs to know if we will be going with the usual paper cover or if we would like to go with plastic cover which is sturdier. Will ask staff opinion on Minder Binders. Will confirm with teachers on basic items that they need to order school supplies in bulk.
